# **CONSTITUTION**

## **Of the**

# **EASTERN LOUISIANA BAPTIST ASSOCIATION**

### **ARTICLE I. NAME**

The name of this Association shall be the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association (referred to as ELBA), cooperating with the Louisiana Baptist Convention, and the Southern Baptist Convention.

### **ARTICLE II. MISSION**

In order to serve God, the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association will involve and assist churches in a cooperative fellowship to do missions, evangelism, leadership, and ministry support to build the Kingdom of God.

### **ARTICLE III. ARTICLES OF FAITH**

The ELBA Statement of Faith shall be the Baptist Faith and Message as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention at its annual meeting in 2000.

### **ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP**

Membership shall be composed of messengers elected by and representing the churches affiliated with this body. When such messengers are approved by the Association, they shall be seated and entitled to participate in the affairs of the body. Qualifications for membership and messenger representation are outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 1.

### **ARTICLE V. AUTHORITY**

This Association shall never attempt to exercise any power or control over any church, but may offer counsel founded upon Biblical principles. Although the Association recognizes and affirms the autonomous nature of each church, ELBA is an autonomous body and therefore reserves the right to determine its own policies and direct its own business.

### **ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS**

Officers of this Association must be members in good standing of churches within the Association, and be recognized for their loyalty to Southern Baptist doctrines. At the May Executive Board Meeting of the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association the following officers shall be elected to serve for a one year term beginning at the close of the next Associational Annual Meeting:

1. Moderator, who shall serve as Chairman of the Executive Board and President of the Corporation; the Moderator shall be limited to two consecutive terms.
2. Vice-Moderator, who shall serve as Vice-Chairman of the Executive Board, and Vice-President of the Corporation;
3. Clerk, who shall serve as the Secretary of the Executive Board and Secretary of the Corporation;
4. Treasurer, who shall serve as Treasurer of the Executive Board and Treasurer of the Corporation.

Other officers and committee chairpersons may be elected by the Executive Board or by the Messengers at the Associational Annual Meeting as needed by the Association. Selection and service of these officers are outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 2.

### **ARTICLE VII. TRUSTEES**

The Trustees of the Association shall be the Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, and Associational Missions Coordinator.

### **ARTICLE VIII. MINISTRY TEAMS**

This body shall encourage and promote such Associational Ministry Teams as deemed necessary for the work of the Association. The leader of each Ministry Team shall be elected by the Association. The Team Leader, in cooperation with the Associational Council, shall be responsible for securing support personnel as outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 7.

### **ARTICLE IX. EXECUTIVE BOARD**

The Association shall have an Executive Board consisting of one pastor (or his designee) and one lay member from each church or mission. The Executive Board is to attend to all matters of the Association between sessions and carry out all directions given by the Association. Selection and service of this board is outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 6.

### **ARTICLE X. ASSOCIATIONAL COUNCIL**

The Associational Council shall consist of all elected Associational Officers, Ministry Team Leaders, and the chairperson of each standing committee. The council shall meet to recommend planning and programming to the Association as outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 3.

### **ARTICLE XI. MEETINGS**

The Association Annual Meeting shall be held in the month of October. The Associational Arrangements Committee shall recommend the exact time, date, place, and preacher for the annual session as outlined in ELBA Bylaws, Section 8. Special associational meetings may be held as are deemed wise for the promotion of its work. The Executive Board shall have the power to change the stated time and place of these meetings in case of emergency or necessity.

### **ARTICLE XII. COMMITTEES**

Standing committees deemed necessary for the work of the Association shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee and shall be elected by the Association at the Associational Annual Meeting. Any ad hoc or special committee deemed necessary shall be named by either the Associational Council or Moderator. Committees of the Association shall function as outlined in the ELBA Bylaws, Section 8.

### **ARTICLE XIII. AMENDMENTS**

The Constitution may be amended at any regular session of the Association by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the messengers present. Notice of such changes shall be published twice in the Associational newsletter prior to such meeting, presented in the first session of the annual meeting, and voted on before the close of the last session.

## **BYLAWS**

Of the

## **EASTERN LOUISIANA BAPTIST ASSOCIATION**

### **SECTION 1. MEMBERSHIP**

#### **A. MESSENGERS**

Each church shall be entitled to three (3) messengers for the first fifty (50) members and one (1) additional messenger for each twenty-five (25) members, up to a maximum of fifteen (15) messengers. This Association may refuse to seat messengers who are not in fellowship or doctrinal agreement with this body. It may also refuse to seat messengers whose church is not in fellowship or doctrinal agreement with this body.

## B. AFFILIATION

### 1. CHURCH AFFILIATION

#### a. Church Actions

Any church seeking affiliation with this Association which is not a mission sponsored by a member church of this Association, shall take the following steps:

- 1) Present a letter of petition to the Executive Board at any regular session of business, at least 90 days prior to the annual meeting.
- 2) Provide a copy of the minutes of the church business meeting in which the vote to pursue affiliation is recorded.
- 3) Provide information concerning the manner by which the church was constituted.
- 4) Submit a copy of the minutes of the church business meeting in which the vote to adopt the Baptist Faith and Message, year 2000, is recorded.
- 5) Provide evidence of the church's commitment to both support Associational activities and provide regular and systematic financial support. (i.e. statement concerning intent to promote Associational events within the church, statement of anticipated financial support to the Association and Cooperative Program [explain Cooperative Program if needed]).
- 6) Provide evidence of the church's commitment to support and attend both the Associational Annual Meeting and the Executive Board meetings. (i.e. naming prospective Executive Board Members, statement of intent to elect messengers to the Associational Annual Meeting).

#### b. Association Actions

- 1) Letters of petition seeking Associational membership shall be referred to the Credentials Committee, which shall make a recommendation at the Associational Annual Meeting.
- 2) The Credentials Committee shall guide the petitioning church through the affiliation process.
- 3) Petitioning churches shall be taken under watchcare of the Association for one year. While under watchcare the petitioning church will be invited and encouraged to participate fully in Associational activities, but will not be seated as messengers at the Associational Annual Meeting. Members of said church will not be allowed to be elected to positions of Associational leadership. At the conclusion of the year of watchcare, at the next Associational Annual Meeting, the Credentials Committee shall make the recommendation to either accept or reject the petition.

### 2. MISSION AFFILIATION

#### a. Mission Actions

A mission that has constituted, having been sponsored by a local ELBA church, shall be considered for admission into the Association as a church upon meeting the following requirements:

- 1) Present a letter of petition to the Executive Board at any regular session of business, at least 90 days prior to the annual meeting.
- 2) Provide a copy of the minutes of the church business meeting in which the vote to pursue affiliation is recorded.
- 3) Provide information concerning the manner by which the church was constituted.
- 4) Submit a copy of the minutes of the church business meeting in which the vote to adopt the Baptist Faith and Message, year 2000, is recorded.
- 5) Provide evidence of the church's commitment to both support Associational activities and provide regular and systematic financial support. (i.e. statement concerning intent to promote Associational events within the church, statement of anticipated financial support to the Association and Cooperative Program [explain Cooperative Program if needed]).
- 6) Provide evidence of the church's commitment to support and attend both the Associational Annual Meeting and the Executive Board meetings. (i.e. naming prospective Executive Board Members, statement of intent to elect messengers to the Associational Annual Meeting).

b. Association Actions

- 1) When a letter of petition is received by the Association, the Credentials Committee shall guide the petitioning church through the affiliation process.
- 2) The one-year watchcare period shall be waived.
- 3) The Credentials Committee shall make a recommendation at the Associational Annual Meeting to either accept or reject the petition.

C. REMOVAL

The Association shall be at liberty to withdraw its affiliation from any church which has failed to evidence doctrinal soundness, spiritual unanimity, accord, and cooperation with the Association. The following action shall be taken:

The Executive Board shall refer such actions to the Credentials Committee for review and recommendation at the next Associational Annual Meeting.

D. WITHDRAWAL

Any church may withdraw from cooperation with the Association by providing the following:

1. A copy of the business meeting minutes of the church as evidence of the church's desire to withdraw.
2. A written notice of the intention to withdraw from the Association and the effective date of the withdrawal to be presented at the Associational Annual Meeting.

## SECTION 2. OFFICERS

Officers of this Association must be members in good standing of churches within the Association, and be recognized for their loyalty to Southern Baptist doctrines. Duties of the officers shall be as follows:

**The Moderator** shall call to order and preside over the meetings of the Association, Executive Board, and Associational Council in an orderly manner and Christian spirit. He may have other officers of the Association to preside on such occasions as he may see fit. The Moderator may appoint ad hoc or special committees as necessary to accomplish the work of the Association. The Moderator shall be limited to two consecutive terms. Upon vacating the office at the end of a second term, he may not succeed himself for the period of one year.

**The Vice-Moderator** shall assist the Moderator and preside at his request or in his absence. The Vice-Moderator may, if the Moderator so directs, preside over sessions of the Associational Annual Meeting.

**The Clerk** shall keep a full and accurate record of all proceedings of the Associational Annual Meeting, the Associational Council, and the Executive Board. He/she shall provide all minutes of previous meetings in written form, and at all meetings, have on hand, minutes from the previous year.

**The Treasurer** shall receive all funds of and for the work of the Association and shall disburse them in accordance with the instructions of the Association. The Treasurer is to be a member of the Associational Council, the Finance Committee, and an ex-officio member of the Executive Board unless elected as an Executive Board member by his church. He shall:

- keep an accurate record of all monies received, with their sources and designations
- review vouchers for compliance to financial policy and approve/disapprove payment
- be authorized to sign checks according to financial policy
- review the monthly financial report
- make quarterly reports to the Executive Board and the Associational Annual Meeting for approval
- be responsible for the filing and payment of quarterly taxes.

**The Historian** shall make a record of the current events and provide a printed annual report at the Associational Annual Meeting for adoption.

Other officers and committee chairpersons may be elected by the Executive Board or by the Messengers at the Associational Annual Meeting as needed by the Association.

### **SECTION 3. ASSOCIATIONAL COUNCIL**

**Composition:** The Council is composed of the Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, Historian, Ministry Team Leaders, and the chairperson of each standing committee. The Associational Missions Coordinator and Associate Associational Missions Coordinator are ex-officio members.

**Responsibilities:** This council shall appoint Nominating Committee Members, set and oversee the associational calendar, coordinate the work and ministry of the Association, and appoint ad hoc and special committees as needed.

**Meetings:** The Associational Council shall meet at least one week prior to sessions of the Executive Board and other times as necessary.

### **SECTION 4. TRUSTEES**

The Trustees will perform the execution of the Association's legal documents as required by law in effectuation of direction given by and only with the prior approval of the Association's messengers or Executive Board between sessions. The Trustees shall have no authority or powers except those explicitly granted to them by the Association's Articles of Incorporation. The messengers may delegate authority to officers or committees; however, the Trustees shall be accountable to the messengers as provided in the Association's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws.

### **SECTION 5. ASSOCIATIONAL MEETINGS**

This Association shall meet annually in the month of October. The exact time, date and place shall be recommended by an Associational Annual Meeting Arrangements Committee and approved in the annual session.

Special meetings of the membership of the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association may be called by the following: 1) Executive Board; 2) Moderator/Chairman; or in his absence, 3) Vice-Moderator/Vice-Chairman; or in the absence of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman, 4) Clerk/Secretary; 5) or any three members of the Executive Board.

Notice of all regular and special meetings of the membership and the Executive Board shall be given by email or written notice at least seven days prior to such meetings. The purpose of special meetings shall be included in the written notice.

### **SECTION 6. EXECUTIVE BOARD**

**Selection and service:** Nominations for membership on the Executive Board shall be made by the church or mission church, but members must be elected by the Association. The Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, Associational Missions Coordinator (AMC), and Associate Associational Missions Coordinator (AAMC) shall be ex-officio members of the Executive Board. Ex-officio members will not have a right to vote unless they are also members of the Executive Board elected as representatives of their respective church or mission.

**Responsibilities:** The Executive Board is to attend to all matters of the Association between sessions and carry out all directions approved by the Association in its Annual Meeting. They are to make an annual report to the Association of all work implemented. The Executive Board shall steward a Policies and Procedures Manual for the Association. The Executive Board may request a financial audit at such time as it may deem necessary and shall furnish the audit to churches that are members of the Association.

**Meetings:** The Executive Board shall hold quarterly meetings. The Moderator may call a special meeting of the Board when necessary. All Executive Board Members must be notified at least two (2) weeks in advance of any meeting not on the Board-approved schedule.

## **SECTION 7. MINISTRY TEAMS**

This Association shall maintain such ministry teams as may be deemed necessary to achieve its mission and that of its member congregations. Ministry Team Leaders shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee and presented in the May Executive Board Meeting and assume the responsibility of their respective positions immediately following the Associational Annual Meeting. Ministry Team Leaders may appoint team members as needed in order to assist them in carrying out the team tasks. A list of Ministry Team and Job Descriptions shall be reviewed annually by the Associational Council, and published in the Annual Book of Reports. The Associational Council shall recommend to the Messengers of the Annual Meeting or the Executive Board between sessions the following: (1) addition of Ministry Teams; (2) deletion of non-functioning Ministry Teams; (3) or modification of Ministry Team structure.

## **SECTION 8. COMMITTEES**

**Standing Committees** shall be organized with at least a chairperson and secretary. Standing committee members are elected for three-year rotating terms so as to provide continuity in the work of the committee. The chairperson may serve two years of a three-year term. Each committee shall maintain written records and minutes of all meetings. These records are the property of the Association and will be passed on to subsequent committee leaders and filed at the Association office.

**The Nominating Committee** will be a standing committee consisting of six members appointed by the Associational Council to serve rotating terms. This Committee shall nominate the Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, and Historian. In addition, they shall nominate team leaders with the help and assistance of the above nominees as outlined in Article VII, ELBA Constitution. The Nominating Committee shall nominate members for the Finance Committee (3), Personnel Committee (3), Scholarship Committee (3), and the Annual Meeting Arrangements Committee (3). They shall also nominate Baptist Collegiate Ministry Representatives (2) and Living Waters Baptist Assembly Trustees (4).

**The Finance Committee** shall consist of six members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Association to serve rotating terms. They shall oversee the general financial policies and procedures for accountability. They are to prepare the annual budget for the Association, seeking the input of the Associational Council. Quarterly, the Finance Committee and Treasurer shall review the financial report and present it to the Executive Board and at the Annual Meeting. This Committee is to promote appropriate Associational stewardship emphases. The Committee shall call for an annual financial review from a qualified Association member. This Committee shall be assisted by the Associational Treasurer.

**The Personnel Committee** shall consist of three members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Association to serve rotating terms. They are to: 1) provide counsel to the AMC concerning the employment and termination of all Associational employees, 2) recommend salaries and compensation packages for all employees, 3) define employee job descriptions in cooperation with the Moderator and Associational Missions Coordinator, and 4) cooperate with the Associational Missions Coordinator in employee supervision.

**The Credentials Committee** shall consist of three members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Association to serve rotating terms. They shall: 1) examine petitioning documents, 2) meet with petitioning congregations to orient them to the purposes and work of the Association, and 3) provide them with Associational information (i.e. most recent Associational Minutes Book, Budget, Constitution and Bylaws, Calendar, Leadership, Ministry Teams, etc.). This Committee shall also investigate matters concerning membership referred to it by the Association.

**The ELBA Scholarship Committee** shall consist of three members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Association to serve rotating terms. The Committee shall have sole authority in granting the two Associational scholarships and report the names of the recipients at the Spring Executive Board Meeting. Scholarships shall be awarded to students attending or desiring to attend either Louisiana College or New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary according to the adopted scholarship policies.

**The Missions and Ministry Center Committee** shall consist of six members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Association to serve rotating terms. The Committee shall 1) manage the operation, maintenance, and the use of the Missions and Ministry facility; 2) oversee and provide guidance related to the use of the Church Incubator facility.

**Ad Hoc and Special Committees** shall be appointed for the duration of the task. Special committees are appointed for a task that recurs annually. Each committee shall maintain written records and minutes of all meetings. These records are the property of the Association and will be passed on to subsequent committee leaders and filed at the Association office.

**The Annual Meeting Arrangements Committee** shall be a special committee appointed at least three months prior to the present year's annual meeting for the purpose of recommending the time, place, and preacher and planning the program for the Associational Annual Meeting of the following year. The Committee shall provide the information to the Associational Council in time for the proposed time, place and preacher to be printed in the Book of Reports and the Annual Minutes Book.

**The Resolutions Committee** shall be a special committee appointed for the purpose of receiving and preparing resolutions to be presented at the Associational Annual Meeting.

**Living Waters Baptist Assembly (LWBA) Trustees** shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee. Four members are elected to serve on the LWBA Board of Trustees for three-year terms on a rotation system and to act as a liaison between the Assembly and the Association.

**Baptist Collegiate Ministry (BCM) Representatives** shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee. Two members are elected to serve for three-year terms on a rotation system. They assist in providing direction in the administration of the BCM ministry and act as a liaison between the BCM and the Association.

#### **SECTION 9. MISSIONS AND MINISTRY CENTER AND CHURCH INCUBATOR**

Associational Missions and Ministry Center shall be used for the following purposes: 1) Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association Offices; 2) Disaster Relief Chain Saw Unit; 3) Associational Volunteer Builders Team; 4) Associational Party Trailer; 5) Future ministry units or teams may be added as opportunities present themselves. Additionally, these facilities shall be used as a Church Incubator for new mission church starts. All terms of agreement between the new mission and the Association are covered in the Church Incubator Policies and Procedures Manual.

#### **SECTION 10. PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE**

This Association shall be governed by *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised*, 10th ed. (Cambridge, Mass.: Perseus Publishing, 2000).

#### **SECTION 11. FISCAL YEAR**

This Association's fiscal year shall be from January 1 to December 31 inclusive.

#### **SECTION 12. RECORDS**

Records of the Association shall be protected from fire, theft, and other damages with regard to the importance of such records, and shall be open for public review by members of the Association upon written request and authorized by the Association and/or the Executive Board.

#### **SECTION 13. REPORTS**

All Associational Ministry Teams and standing committees shall provide written reports at the regular meetings of the Executive Board. Ad hoc and special committees shall provide written reports to the Executive Board as deemed necessary or as requested by the Moderator.

#### **SECTION 14. AMENDMENTS**

These Bylaws may be amended by a simple majority of messengers present at the Associational Annual Meeting provided notice of change has been given as stated in Article XII of the Constitution.

1. Pre-session/congregational worship was under the leadership of David Chelette, Worship Leader at Riverside Baptist Church, Watson. Music selections included: “*Holy Spirit, Rain Down*”, “*Here Am I to Worship*”, “*Worthy of Worship*”, “*I Worship You, Almighty God*” and “*O Worship the King*”.
2. Larry Hubbard, Pastor of Riverside Baptist Church, welcomed messengers and guests. He read Scripture from Acts 2:36-42 and led in our opening prayer.
3. The opening session of the One Hundred Sixty-Eighth Annual Meeting of the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association was called to order at 5:15 p.m. at Riverside Baptist Church, Watson, by Vice Moderator, Tim Norris, who expressed gratitude to Riverside for hosting the meeting and reminded messengers and guests to sign in at the registration table.
4. Dr. Joe Alain, Pastor of Hebron, Denham Springs, made the following motion: **“I make a motion that we be convened for business and that those messengers registered and that other duly certified messengers who arrive later be organized into a body for the purpose of carrying on the Associational work and whatever business might be transacted”**. Second by Larry Hubbard. Motion carried.
5. Jerry Ballard, Satsuma, made the following motion: **“I make a motion that the printed program, along with any additions or corrections be adopted as printed”**. Second by Paul Taylor. Motion carried.
6. Willis Easley, Pastor of Christ’s Community, Denham Springs, made the following motion: **“I make a motion that the Book of Reports be adopted as printed”**. Second by Fred Dyess. Motion carried.
7. The Vice Moderator, Tim Norris, called for resolutions to be submitted in writing to the Resolutions Committee members: Richard Blue, Pastor at Walker Baptist, Walker, serving as Committee Chairman; Earnest Graham, Minister of Education at Amite, Denham Springs; and Howard Turner, Pastor at Live Oak, Watson.
8. Fred Dyess, Pastor of Victory, Walker, Chairman of the Credentials Committee, along with its members, Paul Taylor, Pastor of Pine Grove, Livingston and Tom Higginbotham, Interim Pastor of Don Avenue, Denham Springs, bring the following resolution:  
**“Whereas, The Central Baptist Church of Gonzales has completed a two-year watchcare period; and  
Whereas, The church continues to desire membership in the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association; now, therefore, be it  
Resolved, That Central Baptist Church of Gonzales be received into full membership of Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association and those messengers elected by the church and present be seated for this 168<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the Association.”**  
The resolution carried and the members of Central Baptist Church of Gonzales were formally welcomed into the fellowship of the Association by the applause of the body.
9. Trey Cowell, Team Leader, gave the Missions Team report. He gave a brief overview of the First Annual Associational Mission Trip to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Eight ELBA churches sent forty-three people to do God’s work on this first Associational sponsored mission trip. He pointed out that several decisions for Christ and professions of faith were made, both by an attendee and people in the mission field area. Bro. Trey also encouraged member churches to utilize the Associational Party Trailer as a Church outreach tool in their local communities.
10. Andrew Voss, Pastor of Satsuma, Livingston, made the following motion on behalf of the Finance Committee: **“The Finance Committee of Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association recommends that Section 11. FISCAL YEAR of the BYLAWS be changed to read, “This Association’s fiscal year shall be from January 1 to December 31 inclusive”. NOTE: The present fiscal year is from September 1 to August 31”**.

A brief time of discussion followed with no one speaking against the motion. This motion will be voted on in Session 2.

11. Kelly Smith, Treasurer, gave the Annual Treasurer's Report. She asked attendees to view the report in the Annual Book of Reports. Andrew Voss questioned data in the treasurer's report versus data in the 2010 Statistical Summary. Ginger Glascock answered Andrew Voss' question.
12. Tim Norris, Vice Moderator, called for a special motion to be presented. Dr. Richard Blue, Pastor of Walker, made the following motion: **"I move that Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association, in light of Pastor Appreciation Month, receive a love offering in appreciation of our Associational Missionaries, David Brown and Freddie Arnold."** Second by Howard Turner, Pastor, Live Oak. No discussion. Motion carried. Carl Sullivan, Pastor, Gray's Creek, Denham Springs, led the Association in prayer before receiving the offering. Love offering total \$1550.00.
13. Tim Norris, Vice Moderator, introduced the following representatives from fraternal institutions attending our Annual Meeting and gave each an opportunity to make brief comments to those in attendance. Charles Harper and his wife Doris came representing the North American Mission Board as Mission Service Corps Representatives. Representing Louisiana Baptist Children's Home and Sellers Maternity House was Kenneth Hudson. Representing the Louisiana Baptist Convention, Pastoral Leadership Team was, Stacey Morgan. Glenda Bell represented Camp Living Waters. Bret Maranda came representing Louisiana College. Representing the Baptist Collegiate Ministries from Southeastern Louisiana University was Joe Kovac. Non-fraternal institutional representative, Ray McCon, Walker Baptist Church, Walker, reminded Associational Church leaders of the upcoming "4Day Jesus", youth revival at Walker Baptist Church, Walker, November 1-4, from 5:30 p.m. till 8:30 p.m. each evening.
14. Larry Hubbard, Pastor of Riverside, Watson, gave instruction to attendees regarding the route to the dining hall, then led in our mealtime prayer. Session 1 of this Annual Meeting was dismissed to the dining hall for "Dinner with David and Freddie."
15. The "Dinner with David and Freddie" presentation was divided into two parts. Part one, entitled "Livingston Parish Growth Factors" was hosted by Freddie Arnold, Associate Associational Missions Coordinator. Part two, entitled "Trends in Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association" was hosted by David Brown, Associational Missions Coordinator.
16. Session 2 of the Annual meeting began with David Chelette, Worship Leader at Riverside, Watson, singing "*Amazing Grace*."
17. Wendell Dorman, Pastor of First Baptist Holden, Holden, welcomed guests and messengers and read Scripture from Acts 5:28, 30-31, 38-39. He then led in our Session 2 opening prayer.
18. Tim Norris, Vice Moderator, thanked Riverside for hosting this year's Annual Meeting and for the wonderful meal provided. The Vice Moderator called Session 2 to order and reminded those in attendance, both guests and messengers who have not registered to please do so.
19. David Chelette, representing the 2011 Annual Meeting Arrangement Committee (David Brown, David Chelette, Larry Hubbard and Tim Norris) brought the following motion: **"The 2011 Annual Meeting of The Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association shall be held on October 10, 2011. The time and place are yet to be named"**. Motion carried.
20. The Vice Moderator recognized Andrew Voss, to reread the Finance Committee, Session 1 motion. After the motion was reread, the Vice Moderator called for a vote. Motion carried. (See Item 10 of these minutes for the complete motion.)
21. Dr. Richard Blue, Chairman of the Resolutions Committee brought the following resolution before the body for consideration:  
**"Whereas, Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association exists to serve the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, Jesus Christ. Thereby the messengers of the One Hundred Sixty-Eighth Annual Meeting of Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association wish to take this opportunity to express our appreciation and gratitude to the many people who throughout the year exhibit leadership in guiding and planning the ministry of our Association.  
TO Riverside Baptist Church, Pastor Larry Hubbard, for graciously hosting our Annual Meeting on Monday, October 11, 2010 and;**

**TO David Chelette for leading us in worship;**

**TO our Moderator, James Cowell for his guidance throughout the year and Vice Moderator, Tim Norris for his leadership during our meeting;**

**TO David Brown, Associational Missions Coordinator, for his continued faithfulness and wisdom;**

**TO Freddie Arnold, Associate Associational Missions Coordinator, for his assistance and leadership for the Association;**

23. David Chelette, Worship Leader at Riverside, brought the special music for the evening, singing “*Your Grace Still Amazes Me*”.
24. Dr. Scott Drumm’s presentation focused on the “Cooperative Program”. Dr. Drumm began his presentation by pointing out that, “Baptist are different”. W. Terral, Interim Pastor at Judson; Stephen Morgan, Youth Minister at Riverside; Willis Ray Curtis, Associate Pastor/Minister of Evangelism at Victory.
27. Tim Norris, Vice Moderator called for a motion to adjourn. Dr. Richard Blue made the motion to adjourn this Annual Meeting of the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association. Second by Fred Dyess. Motion carried.
28. David Brown, ELBA Missions Coordinator led in our closing prayer for new church staff members and the Associational Leadership for the coming year. This meeting of the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association was adjourned.

## **2010 ANNUAL REPORT**

A few weeks ago, Jenelle and I went with our daughter, her husband and his mother, our 5 year-old grandson and 3-year-old granddaughter to see the Southern Living Idea Home in Covington. After touring the house, we then went through several other “open houses.” After ascending the stairs in one of the magnificent homes, Jenelle reported that our granddaughter looked around and said, “Oh my goodness!” That was such a surprising and revealing comment from one so young.

As I think about serving in the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association and look around at the things God is doing and enjoy the fellowship of believers, I’d have to copy my granddaughter and say, “Oh my goodness!”

In this report, I want to take time to share some personal ministry highlights since our last Annual Associational Meeting

The Lord has allowed me to preach in 11 of the churches in the association, some only once and others several times. It was such a privilege to preach at the LBC Annual WMU meeting in Covington this past March and to bring a missions message for New Zion Baptist Church in Covington as part of their Georgia Barnette State Missions Emphasis.

One of the privileges of the Missions Coordinator is to assist with training opportunities for the churches. During the year, three churches took advantage of Pastor Search Team Training and another church took advantage of Deacon Ministry Training.

The ELBA Church Planting Team has begun to do some significant work in exploring the need and opportunity for church planting in the association. Currently, the team is in the process of assessing the needs in the parish and will begin developing an associational church-planting strategy and process. As part of their work, they have already provided each church with two significant pieces of information. The first was a 20-year statistical summary based on the information submitted by the churches on the Annual Church Profiles. The second is a copy of the demographics revealing the community information within a 1-mile ring of the church. The team wanted to provide this information so that each church could assess their ministry progress and see what the opportunities are for ministry enhancement. In addition, we have explored the development of an Hispanic ministry in the Maurepas area of the parish.

As the Missions Coordinator, it is a privilege to work with our four mission congregations. Christ’s Community is a mission of Judson. One Life is a mission of Walker. South Walker is a mission of Hebron, and Victory is a mission of Macedonia. Each of these mission congregations has experienced significant growth through the year.

It is such a blessing that the Association provides the opportunity for me to participate in conferences, conventions, and training events. Those in which I participated this year include the LBC annual meeting in Shreveport, an LBC Executive Board Orientation in Alexandria, the Mid-America Associational Personnel Peer Learning Event in Grapevine, Texas, the Associational Leadership Planning Conference at FBC Pineville, the LBC Directors of Missions Retreat in Shreveport, and the Blitz on the Bayou at Greenwell Springs Baptist Church.

Here is a list of other ministry opportunities in which your Associational Missions Coordinator had the privilege of participating: inspirational speaker at the Denham Springs Christian Academy Graduation Service at Northside; the ELBA Mission Trip to Tulsa, Oklahoma; the Ordination Council and Service for Matthew McCorkle at FBC Holden; budget consultation for Calvary; partnering with the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary and the Baptist Association of Greater Baton Rouge to provide Conflict Intervention Training for a group of ELBA pastors at Camp Living Waters; offering the prayer of dedication at the North Corbin Elementary Gym Dedication; helping deliver the 147 Buckets of Hope for the Gulf to the Bayou Baptist Association office in Houma, LA; providing Ministry Supervision for a Seminary Student from ELBA; and serving as the guest speaker for the men’s retreat of New Life Baptist church of Covington, TX.

As I think back at these ministry opportunities and others, too numerous to mention, I again repeat what my granddaughter said, “Oh my goodness!” GOD IS GOOD!

### **2009- 2010 Annual Report**

As I think back over the past year of work in ELBA I have a very fulfilling feeling about the ministry in ELBA. It has been a fast and exciting year of work. I feel that God has blessed the efforts of my leadership and the ministry teams efforts over this past year of work. I appreciate each team member's efforts and the cooperation of Bro. David Brown.

The work this year has centered on the areas of construction, missions & ministry and Sunday School Leader Training.

#### **Sunday School Leader Training:**

On February 27 an ELBA Sunday School leader training event was conducted at Walker Baptist Church for Sunday School Leadership. Seventy-five people attended the training session on a Saturday morning. Our leadership team did an excellent job of leading the sessions. We continue to get positive comments about that event.

The Vacation Bible School Clinic was the next big training event of the year. One hundred and eighty-one people from thirty-two of our churches attended the training event at Judson Baptist Church. Thanks to Rebecca Bridevaux, VBS Director, and her team for a very successful training event. According to the VBS Reports from the churches we are seeing a positive result of this training.

#### **Construction:**

The Missions and Ministry Center Team has invested many hours of the last year developing a plan for the new ELBA Missions and Ministry Center to occupy the former Eden Baptist Church property. That task was completed in January of this year and we signed with Louisiana Baptist Builders to begin renovations in June. In the closing days of planning and preparation for work to begin, the Louisiana Department of Transportation notified us of their plans to build a new intersection at the Eden Church Road and Hwy. 190. This plan put our plans into jeopardy because of needed right of way access adjacent to our building.

The Missions and Ministry Center Team along with staff decided to put on hold the renovation project until the right of way issue was settled. We are at this time on hold with the renovation project and working to settle right of way plans for the road construction project. We will continue to work toward a solution to this situation. Thanks to the Missions and Ministry Center Team for their continuing and diligent work.

#### **Missions and Ministry:**

The third area of work this year has been the On Mission Celebration, the ELBA Missions Trip and Mission Construction.

The **On Mission Celebration** was conducted Saturday and Sunday, May 1 and 2. It consisted of two major parts: a mission rally and rotating missionaries speaking in churches on Sunday. The Saturday rally was held at the Amite Baptist Church on Saturday evening consisting of a Missions Fair, a meal and a Missions Worship Service. Twenty three missionaries were enlisted to be present for the Missions Fair to show and tell about their work, participate in the worship service and speak in 22 of our churches. The worship rally was a tremendous success. Approximately 400 people participated in the service as the Flags of the Nations were presented, music was sung, the Word was preached and a commitment time was presented. Rev. Mickey Caison was the keynote speaker for the evening and God blessed our hearts through him. Congratulations to the planning team for a job well done.

**Mission Construction** was a very active part of the ministry this year. Our ELBA Mission Builders participated in two construction projects this year. Nineteen members of this group went to Marksville, LA for a week to help build a mission church in that area. Another team went to Crosby, MS to help Bro. Steve Hays build an addition to the church there. Another team of six or seven men went to Memphis, TN to help hang and finish Sheetrock in homes that were flooded in that area. God has blessed us with people that believe in being on mission.

The **Buckets of Hope for Haiti** was a very successful mission project for ELBA. We joined our SBC brothers and sisters in collecting buckets of food for Haiti after the earthquake there. You provided 397 buckets of food to be given to Haiti. Those buckets along with thousands of others are now being distributed.

The **Buckets of Hope for the Coast** plea went out after the Gulf oil spill to help the fishermen and employees laid off from their jobs. You responded to this need and provided 147 buckets of food. These buckets were delivered to the Bayou Baptist Association and DOM Joe Arnold.

The **ELBA Broken Arrow, OK Mission Trip** was another major area of missions and ministry involving the association. The Missions Team worked very diligently for a year planning the first ever ELBA Mission Trip. This event occurred in July. A team of forty three people from eight churches drove to Arrow Heights Baptist Church in Broken Arrow, OK to work in two of the mission points that they sponsor. One team worked in the Livingstone Baptist Church doing Vacation Bible School, building repair and renovation. Another team worked in the Day Springs Villa Battered Women's Shelter cleaning and repainting a section of that facility. Also, a couple of teams were sent out to help complete projects started by other groups. Three children and one adult were saved in the VBS project. Praise the Lord it has been a fantastic year!!

## **Christian Social Services Team**

The past year has been one of seeking God and asking for His direction in helping our community and the ELBA churches with social needs that arise every day. Beginning in January of this year, the committee began discussing the need for a Christian Counseling Center in Livingston Parish. God has graciously put together a group of counselors who are ready to offer their services. The committee is continuing to meet and work out the location and/or use of buildings for this center. We have put together a vision /mission statement and a strategic plan to begin ministering in our community. This was shared with the pastors in attendance at the Ministers Conference held at Northside Baptist Church on September 13. We are currently in the process of completing the operations and procedures manual.

We also looked at the possibility of purchasing Charity Tracker. This is an online tool that assists churches and other ministries with maintaining a database of benevolent cases. There were three churches in the association that were allowed to pilot the program. Two of the three found it very helpful and within two weeks of using the program, exposed duplicate cases and they were able to save time and money where this was concerned. This is still being examined for possible incorporation with the counseling center.

Our scripture foundation is from *Luke 4:18- 19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.*

We humbly ask the leaders and the members of our associational churches to pray for us as we move forward, following God's direction, in making this a reality for our community.

## **Crisis Ministry Team Report**

Disaster Relief took on a new look in the past year with ELBA responding to more local emergency situations throughout the year versus out of state responses. Unlike most years the need to respond to hurricanes, ice storms, tornadoes and similar major events in other states was at an all time low, not that anyone is complaining. However, your leaders are so grateful to the many team members, who each time the call came placing our team on standby you were willing and ready to respond.

ELBA did have the privilege in May of responding to the flooding that occurred in Tennessee. A team (mainly chain saw trained) that was headed for Nashville to do mud-out work was diverted to Millington, Tennessee (just north of Memphis) to aid in cleanup efforts and begin the process of hanging and floating Sheetrock. ELBA teams worked in five different homes, cleaning and removing the damaged walls. In two homes your teams completed hanging new Sheetrock in the entire home and in one home also completed taping and floating the entire house. It was a remarkable week.

Disaster Relief Training is always available as needed, please let Bro. Tom Higginbotham or myself know any time we can be of assistance. Bro. Tom does a wonderful job in ensuring our chain saw equipment and trailer are always ready to roll whenever the call comes.

## Fall 2010 Southeastern BCM Report

Great things are happening at the BCM! Students are being reached through evangelism and outreach, renewed in their hearts and minds through encountering God's Word, and released into the local churches, the campus, and the world to make a difference for the glory of Christ!

One of the challenges over the summer was the need to hire two new staff members, and God has graciously blessed us with some phenomenal people! Our new Administrative Assistant is Stephanie Fitzpatrick, a member and choir participant at Woodland Park Baptist Church in Hammond, and our new Ministry Intern is Joseph Kovacs, a member and Sunday School teacher at Crossgate Church in Robert. I praise God that he has allowed us to have such a great staff!

Another amazing work of God is that we have had over 90 students get plugged in to Covenant Groups (small groups)! We have assembled ten Covenant Groups which are gender-specific, five women's groups and five men's groups, who meet weekly for Bible study, prayer, fellowship, encouragement, and accountability.

God has really blessed our Covenant Group ministry, and the BCM as a whole, because of the faithfulness and godliness of our Leadership Team. We currently have 21 students on Leadership Team, ten of which are Discipleship leaders and eleven Planning Leaders. The Discipleship leaders facilitate the Bible studies for their Covenant Groups and the Planning leaders are co-leaders for their Covenant Groups.

Our two main outreach activities are Free Lunch on Wednesdays and FUSE worship service on Thursdays nights. We have had great response from the Free Lunches, and it has been such a blessing to partner with our local churches in this effort to minister to the campus. Our worship services have had breath-taking turnouts and amazing movements of God's Spirit! We have averaged this semester 120 students in worship, about 30 above our average last year.

Our students are faithfully seeking the Lord and centering their lives on His Word, and He has been faithful to bless our efforts at the BCM. Never before have we seen such a passion for discipleship, evangelism, and studying the Scriptures as we have seen this semester! The Southeastern BCM is an exciting place to be!
